LEARN THE SIGNS, GET THE FACTS

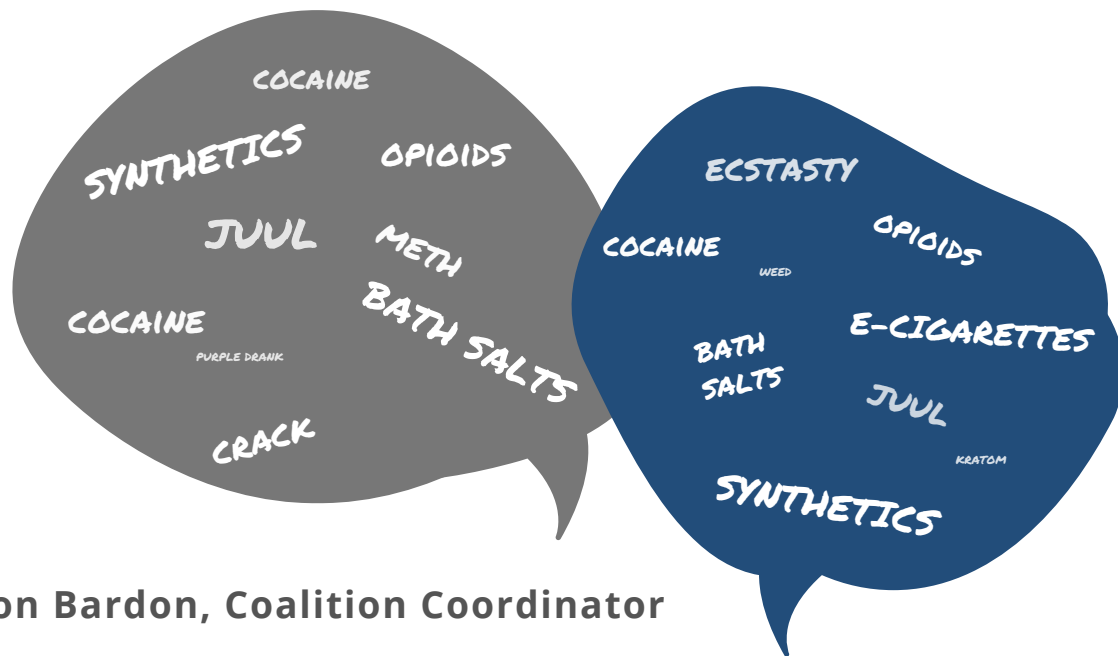
