## Supplies

- Construction paper
- Pen or pencil
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Wax paper
- Old crayons
- Crayon sharpener, plastic knife or safety scissors
- Old towels
- Iron & ironing board
- Stapler

## Directions

- Gather your supplies.
- Use construction paper to design a "window frame." [Click here for template.](#)
- Cut out "window panes" in the construction paper.
- Measure a piece of wax paper to fit the "window frame."
- Place an old towel on an ironing board and place wax paper on top.
- Shave old crayons on the wax paper using a crayon sharpener, plastic knife or safety scissors (or whatever you feel is safest and most effective.)
- Place another piece of wax paper over shaved crayons and the bottom piece of wax paper.
- Place an old towel on top.
- Iron on high, with no steam.
- Once wax paper and melted crayons have cooled, attach the frame (we used staples).
- Hang in a sunny spot and enjoy your work of art!
