We thank you for working with us to make it through day 60 in our hybrid model. It is important that we work together to continue to make this happen. If you travel, if your child exhibits symptoms or if you are awaiting test results, it is imperative that you follow our guidelines. We are all in this together and it is important that each one of us takes actions that will positively impact all of us. There are no cutting corners with this virus. The plan is to move to Phase II on January 19th 2021. Phase II will have all of the children be in-person with families having the option to be fully remote. . The day will go straight through with age-appropriate snack breaks and no lunch. The children will get a seven period day full day instruction ending at 1:20PM. There will be no hybrid option in Phase II. We will only move to Phase II if the CoVid-19 metrics allow us to do so.

Reminders

Please complete the health screen form each morning.

Please put flashers on when your children get out of your car in the morning and get in your car at pick-up

There is no left turn allowed out of our driveway – even if the sign is not there.

The walking line is for children who have permission to walk home. It is not to be used to avoid being on the pick-up line. No one is to be parked on either side of Green Village Road between Wilmer Street and Kings Road to pick up walkers. The Parish Ministry Center lot and other driveways along this stretch are not for school use. We want to stay on good terms with our neighbors.
