We are notifying you that a student has tested positive for COVID-19. We have coordinated closely with the Madison Health Department to identify any potential close contacts of the faculty member within our school community so that we can identify those who need to quarantine. The last date this individual was in the school building was November 16th.

Cleaning and disinfecting of all exposed areas has already been completed.

The faculty member is isolating and any identified close contacts will not be present in school until they meet the NJDOH criteria for return.

We understand the level of concern regarding COVID-19. Due to the rising transmission rate in NJ, we encourage parents and students to continue following safe practices listed below:

- Staying home when you are sick
- Washing hands with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds often
- Covering coughs and sneezes and properly disposing of tissues
- Limiting close contact with people who are sick
- Do not sharing food, drinks and utensils
- Practicing social distancing (staying at least 6 feet apart)
- Wearing a face covering while in school
- Avoid touching your face
- If you believe you were exposed to someone with COVID-19, please contact us and your local health department immediately and get tested
