All courses will be held at SVMS from 9:15-11:15 am.

1. **Week of June 29 - July 2: Lego Club** (open to incoming 4th, 5th, & 6th graders)
2. **Week of July 6 - July 10: Book Club** - *Mrs. Frisby and the Rats of NIMH* (open to incoming 5th graders)
3. **Week of July 13 - July 17: Writing Club** (open to incoming 4th & 5th graders)
4. **Week of July 27 - July 31: Mini Mock Trial** (open to incoming 5th & 6th graders)
5. **Week of August 3 - August 7: Lego Club** (open to incoming 4th, 5th, & 6th graders)
6. **Week of August 10 - August 14: Creating Comic Strips/Picture Books** (open to incoming 4th, 5th, & 6th graders)

Summer Enrichment Course Descriptions:

- 1. Lego Club: 6/29-7/2; incoming 4th, 5th, & 6th graders** (max #: 25)
Children LOVE LEGOs! They are natural engineers, constantly asking questions and imagining new ideas. Some other important skills children can learn from LEGOs are a sense of accomplishment, persistence, problem solving, science, technology, engineering, creativity, & math. Each day will begin with a new theme and end with everyone sharing his or her creation.
- 2. Book Club: 7/6-7/10; incoming 5th graders** (max #: 25)
Come prepared to read, write, & have lively discussions. We will read the required novel, *Mrs. Frisby and the Rats of NIMH* and work on the required assignment for September.

- 3. Writing Club: 7/13-7/17; incoming 4th & 5th graders** (max #: 15)
We will work on various types of writing this week: descriptive, persuasive, creative, & picture prompts.

- 4. Mini Mock Trial: 7/27-7/31; incoming 5th & 6th graders** (max #: 20)
Take on the role of lawyers, jurors, & witnesses to enact fictitious trials while learning the basics of courtroom procedure, advocacy, negotiation, & public speaking.
