
LAWRENCE GUASTELLA INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC





Dear Parents/Guardians:

Instrumental lessons will once again be offered during the school year. As in the past, I am sure many of you will be interested in taking advantage of this opportunity to enrich your child's education. I'm sure our music program will help add color and distinction to the established character and educational merit of your school. The program works as follows:

- Thirty lessons are offered during the school year. Each lesson runs a total 30 minutes.
- Classes will meet on a designated day during school time. Specific times and first day of classes will be given after enrollments are processed.
- Classes meet only when school is in session. Holidays and other designated "days off" that fall on your assigned lesson day do not count as lesson days. If the teacher is absent from school on a lesson day, that of course in not included as part of the thirty lessons given. However, when school is in session and the teacher is present, attendance is the student's responsibility. Due to problems in scheduling, it is virtually impossible to accommodate individual student absences. (Although, I generally manage to give a few "extra" lessons to address the absentee conflict and help prepare for our concerts.)
- Lessons are available on the following instruments. Please note corresponding grade levels.

ACQUIRING INSTRUMENTS:

- Recorders will be supplied by the company and distributed on the first or second lesson.
- Electronic keyboards can be purchased at most music stores and in the electronics department of most department stores.
 HINT: Ask for standard sized keys, do not purchase a keyboard that is too small (at least

four octaves) and do not pay extra for too many "gimmicks". They are essentially

unimportant.

• Band instruments (flute, clarinet, trumpet, saxophone) may be rented or purchased at most music companies. I have endeavored to locate a company that deals with better quality instruments at more competitive prices. If you wish to rent or purchase through my channels, please check the appropriate line on the registration form and enclose the corresponding fee. I will personally handle all details including pick-up and delivery of instruments.

RENTAL FEES: (9 months) PURCHASE FEES:

Flute, Clarinet, Trumpet \$110.00 .\$350.00 Alto Sax \$155.00 .\$750.00

Please note - rental fees are applied towards the eventual purchasing of the instrument.

PAYMENT:

All students pay an annual registration fee of \$45.00. This fee includes a method book, various paperwork and xeroxing throughout the year.

The charge for each lesson is \$9.00. Payment may be made in two installments:

First Payment: Ten Lessons \$90.00

Registration Fee 45.00

Total \$135.00

Second Payment: Remaining

Twenty Lessons: \$180.00

DISCOUNTS:

- For payment in full: Deduct two lessons (\$18.00) from total.
- For two or more children enrolled: deduct one lesson (\$9.00 per child) from each child's payment.
